

Dr. Emil C. Toescu is head of the Neurobiology of Ageing Laboratory at the College of Medical and Dental Sciences, University of Birmingham, United Kingdom, that centres on investigating the metabolic substrates that define the age-dependent changes in neurophysiological properties that lead to the cognitive impairment of the aged brain. He is also appointed to various research reviewing bodies both at national (MRC, BBSRC) and European level. He is on the editorial board of various learned journals (e.g., Cell Calcium, Frontiers in Ageing, Journal of Cellular and Molecular Medicine) and reviews and edits papers and special issues for a variety of high impact

journals (Trends in Neurosciences, Aging Cell), in addition to contributing chapters to various books and publishing research papers and reviews in high impact specialist and general journals. In addition to the research activity, he also has important teaching duties, as course organiser and administrative functions, as a member of the Senate of the University of Birmingham.
