



**Dr. Remus PRICOPIE** is the Dean and Associate Professor of the College of Communication and Public Relations at the National University of Political Science and Public Administration, where he teaches Public Relations, Corporate Communication, Policy Dialog, History of Public Communication. He is a former spokesperson of the Ministry of Education (1997; 2001), former senior advisor to the minister of education (2002-2003; 2009), and former State Secretary for Higher Education (2007-2008), alumnus of Fulbright New Century Scholarship Program and President of the Romanian-U.S. Fulbright Commission in Bucharest (since January 2009), Chair of the Task Force Fostering and Building Human Capital of the Regional Cooperation Council (since February 2010), and a member of the Romanian Association for the Club of Rome (since 2006). He coordinates several research projects in the area of public communication, internationalization of higher education, policy dialog, and active citizenship, areas in which he has published several books and numerous articles.
